Review of captioned Bureau file has not disclosed sufficient basis in the TWWA goals and activities to support a statutory predication and thereby warrant a continued active investigation of the organization or its leaders and membership per se. Unless you possess additional data not previously furnished the Bureau which would support continued investigation, this investigation should be closed. Remain alert for information which would warrant renewed investigation in accordance with guidelines set out in Manual of Instructions, Section 122.

Where investigations of individuals have been conducted solely on TWWA affiliation, then such cases should be closed. If investigation has disclosed independent activities which would warrant further investigation then the cases should be continued.

Continue to obtain and review copies of the TWWA publication "Triple Jeopardy" and submit same to the Bureau. It is not necessary to prepare a detailed analysis of the newspaper as has been done in the past.

NOTE: TWWA was formed as a result of a split between female and male members of the Student National Coordinating Committee (SNCC) in 1972. TWWA has since been involved in promoting women to study revolutionary theory and successful revolutions to determine what methods can be used to counteract imperialism, racism and chauvanism in the U.S. TWWA is open to women of all races. The TWWA has not advocated an extremist philosophy or policy or participated in activities which would indicate the possible violation of any Federal statutes. The "Triple Jeopardy" publication routinely contains articles relating to other extremist and New Left groups.
