The information from [REDACTED] New York City Police Department (NYCPD), was furnished to SA [REDACTED] on the date noted.

New York sources have been alerted to the existence of the captioned group and have been instructed to immediately furnish any information regarding this group.

As disclosed within, Third World Womens' Alliance (TWWA) shares the office space with SNCC at St. Peter's Episcopal Church, 346 West 20th Street, New York City. Actually as a practical matter, representatives of TWWA and/or SNCC appear to frequent such office space on an erratic and occasional basis.

Numerous telephone inquiries at the rectory have indicated that SNCC and TWWA share space at the above location, but were never able to be contacted there. The minister answering the telephone always advised that they came in "later in the day" and that a subsequent inquiry should be made at a later hour.

The TWWA, as to date, conducted no known demonstration or other disruptive activity, and it appears to be relatively inactive. [REDACTED] who is familiar with Women's Liberation activities in New York City, has indicated that she knows of

b7c no activity conducted by the group nor does she know of any officers of the group other than disclosed within i.e.: the name [REDACTED]
