A confidential source, who has supplied reliable information in the past, advised that [REDACTED] was a leader and/or group leader of the Third World Women's Alliance (TWWA).

The TWWA is headquartered at Saint Peter's Episcopal Church, 346 West 20th Street, New York City, and has approximately 200 members. The organization has been described as fighting against the sex exploitation of women. The TWWA is scheduled to participate in women's conferences to be held in Toronto, Montreal, and Vancouver, Canada, during 1971, which will include women from North Vietnam, North Korea, South Vietnam, Cambodia and Laos.

On March 16, 1971, a representative of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) caused the records of the Bureau of Criminal Identification, New York City Police Department (NYCPD), and the records of the Security and Investigation Section (SIS), NYCPD, to be searched with negative results regarding [REDACTED]
