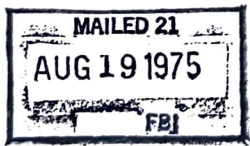
Third World Women's Alliance
Characterization of Subversive Organization
Extremist Matters

The September-October 1971 issue of "Triple Jeopardy", ideological organ of the Third World Women's Alliance (TWWA), stated that the foundation for the TWWA was laid in December, 1968, when a black women's caucus was formed within the Student National Coordinating Committee (SNCC). It was known as the Black Women's Alliance but with expansion to include all Third World Women the name was changed to the TWWA. Its announced objective is the elimination of the triple oppression of Third World Women, imperialism, racism and sexism through the creation of a socialist society. It is located at 26 West 20th Street, New York, NY, and is independent of SNCC.

SNCC was founded in 1960, during the period of civil rights activity in the south. The organization has in the past advocated the use of force to achieve revolutionary goals and the destruction of the capitalistic system of government in the United States.

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
