

1. How do we determine when Governor Edgar will be in town?

Proposal: Mike Stanek will call Matt Krasnowski periodically (we should figure out how often) in Springfield to find out the governor's schedule. If Mike thinks it sounds like a good event to have a CEML presence, he will make appropriate calls to confirm the governor's presence, the time, the place, etc.

2. How do we decide whether or not to respond to Governor Edgar's presence in Chicago?

Proposal: Once Mike Stanek has made the preliminary determination to respond, he will call the PLO, where he can reach Leila and/or Erica. Erica and/or Leila can then call Steve Pick and Seth. These five people, Mike, Leila, Erica, Steve, and Seth, (hereinafter the CEML 5) can make a decision whether or not to go ahead. If they need to reach more people to make the decision, they should feel free to poll and discuss with other CEML members.

3. Once the decision is made to respond to the governor's presence in Chicago, what next?

Proposal: Calls have to be made to our friends immediately to ensure their participation in the action/disruption.

We need to call the people on the list that we assembled last week and 1) make sure these people want to be part of the emergency response, and 2) ask them whether or not they would be willing to call some of their friends after we call them to announce an emergency response. Let people know that we will give them as much advance notice as possible before an action.

The CEML 5 will call the list of possible participants within the next week and ensure their participation. Erica will make up a master list of who is willing to participate in the emergency response.

Thereafter, when the decision has been made to respond, Erica, Mike, Steve, and Seth will call the list, and Leila will call people on CEML list.

4. Erica will be in charge of bringing banners, yellow and red leaflets, bull horn, placards, and stickers to the site. All of this is at the PLO already except banners and placards. Someone needs to deal with getting those items to the PLO.

5. The CEML 5 will serve as a tactical unit at the site. This includes assigning tasks, e.g. distributing placards, asking people to hold the banner, planning the disruption, etc. Steve Pick will also serve as a roving legal monitor. CEML will deal with bail money if and when we need to.

6. After the action has been executed, everyone must help collect items and put back in Erica's car.

*** A caveat to this whole plan is that since we don't know exactly when Edgar will be here, it may be that members of the CEML 5 will be out of town or busy or whatever. So, other people should be more than willing to chip in and help.
