Film- "Klan: Legacy of Hate in America"

On Saturday, December 3, 1983, 25 armed Klansmen, Nazis and members of the Aryan Nations burned 3 crosses in a Black neighborhood in Los Angeles. The Center for Black Survival and the John Brown Anti-Klan Committee have been demonstrating and building a movement to confront this racist terror. While Klan and other racist violence is growing, so is resistance. The Black community of Miami has rebelled 3 times against killer cops that murder Black people and then get acquitted. Here in Chicago, residents of the Washington Park housing project demonstrated to protest the murder of Arlester Walker, a Black man - one of 9 people killed by Chicago police in the last 11 weeks. On March 8th the JBAKC disrupted a live TV appearance of Bill Wilkinson and 2 Klanswomen here in Chicago.

Come and discuss how we can build a movement against the Klan. Learn more about how Black people are organizing to have an independent nation on land in the south - New Afrika - to end once and for all Klan and U.S. government control over their lives.
