MAY 2 - MAY 14
OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA

During the two weeks between May 2 and May 14 the Black Panther Party will hold a massive mobilization of people to demonstrate the revolutionary sentiment of the black community, the international support of the Black Panther Party and the black liberation struggle, and to STOP OAKLAND until Huey P. Newton is set free. The slogan of our activities will be: FREE HUEY - OR THE SKY'S THE LIMIT!

EVENTS:

During this two week period we will schedule and participate in a vast array of diverse events to educate the black community and intimidate the power structure. There will be: rallies, marches, demonstrations, seminars, workshops, conventions, films, dances, picnics, banquets, press conferences, and a final culmination in a Revolutionary Summit Meeting or General Assembly which will issue a final ultimatum to the oppressors on May 14.

LOCATIONS:

We must utilize all the facilities of the Oakland-Berkeley-San Francisco Bay Area for speaking engagements, workshops, seminars, rallies, etc. At hand we will concentrate on the Oakland Auditorium, McKlineman's High School, Merritt College, S.F. State College, Laney Jr. College, the

Fillmore Auditorium, Winterland, the Berkeley Community Theatre, the Greek Theatre, Longshoreman's Hall, Merritt Park, Defremery Park, and, the churches of the black community, specifically St. Augustines, Ephesians, and also Copes Unitarian Church.

VACAVILLE: ELDRIDGE CLEAVER DAY

During this period we will hold some type of special writers seminar or convention or caucus at Vacaville in honor of Eldridge Cleaver, issue a statement on Eldridge's political imprisonment and hold a rally demanding he be set free.

This whole series of events, which will approach in some measure the OLAS conference held in Havana last summer at which Stokely Carmichael was the guest of honor, this whole program designed to place and international focus and direct international attention on the plight of Afro-Americans and the trial of Huey Newton, will be designed to center around Huey P. Newton's trial scheduled to start May 6.

From May 2 to May 5 we will engage in a period of mass mobilization of black, brown, white, yellow, etc. people around the issue of Huey Newton and black political prisoners as the key attack against the black liberation struggle.

From May 6 through May 10, the week during which court can be held, the events will be those which will focus people's attention on the nature and diverse aspects of the black liberation struggle through many kinds of programs and shows and events.

Starting May 11 and ending May 14, there will be a political convention leading to a revolutionary summit, a general assembly on May 14. During this week-end there will be workshops all over the area on the ten point program of the Black Panther Party, the ten basic demands of black people, as the starting point to educating the black community to the point where it believes it has a RIGHT to these things.

We will need a hotel floor to accomodate our dignitaries and a large office or headquarters to centralize the international days of black revolutionary protest. FOSTERS, LEAFLETS, NEWSPAPERS, EN MASSE WILL BE USED.
